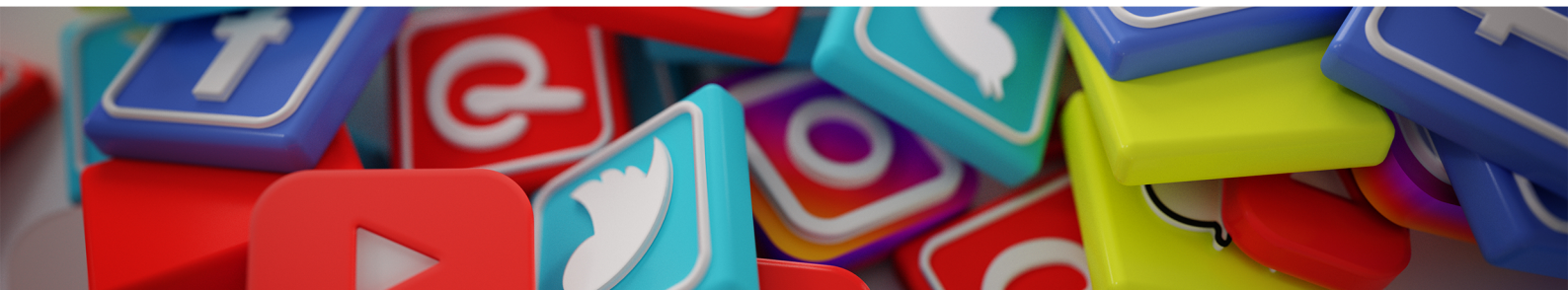

Activity 2 Grammar Present Simple:

Form: We form the present simple with the subject+verb(in the base form)+object.

We use the present simple for facts or general truths: The sun rises in the East.

States or conditions: I was born in London.

Routines: She wakes up at 6am every morning.



E.G I eat pizza and watch video games every Saturday.

We play basketball for a team and we fly to different cities to compete against other teams and fortunately, we win most of our games.

When it comes to the subjects HE, SHE and IT(third person singular) the verb changes.

E.G She eats pizza and watches movies every Saturday.

He plays basketball for a team and he flies to different places and competes against other teams and fortunately, he wins most of his games.



Spelling rules for **HE**, **SHE** and **IT**.

1. Verbs that end in -O, -CH, -SH, -SS, -X, or -Z we add -es in the third person.

Go – goes, catch – catches,
wash – washes, kiss – kisses,
fix – fixes, buzz – buzzes.

2. Verbs that end in a consonant + Y, we remove the Y and add -ies.

Marry – marries, study –
studies, carry – carries, and
worry – worries

3. Verbs that end in a vowel + Y, we just add S.

Play-plays, stay-stays and
enjoy-enjoys.

The vowels in English are: A, E,
I, O, U.

EXAMPLE: I share posts everyday

He, she, it shares posts everyday.

You, we, they share posts everyday.

Present Simple (negative) Form:

Subject+do/does not+verb in base form

We form the present simple negative with do not (don't) for subjects I, you, we, they. And does not (doesn't) for subjects he, she and it.

Here are some examples of negative present simple sentences.

1. The students don't like face2face classes, they prefer learning online.
2. Faisal doesn't use the internet often because he thinks it's bad.
3. Mariam doesn't share her pictures on facebook.
4. In our family we don't talk about technology because my dad doesn't like that topic.
5. I email her everyday but she doesn't email me back.

In the negative form the verb stays the same for all subjects.

Questions in the present simple:

Form: Do/Does + subject+ the base form of the verb.

For example: Do you know how to use this App?
Does she usually text so late?

When we start our questions with Do or Does, we usually have a yes or no answer.

Do the children play in the park every day?
Yes, they do or No, they don't.

Does your teacher give you a lot of homework?
Yes, she does or No, she doesn't.

Adverbs of frequency:

1. Always- 100% of the time

2. Usually – 80-90% of the time.

3. Sometimes – 50% of the time.

4. Never – 0% of the time.



Rules for using them:

These adverbs usually go before the main verb.
They describe how often something happens.

Examples:

Always:

"She always drinks coffee in the morning."

"I always go for a walk after dinner."

Usually:

"He usually arrives at work by 9 AM."

"We usually eat dinner at 7 PM."

Sometimes:

"They sometimes go to the beach on weekends."

"I sometimes read before bed."

Never:

"He never eats junk food."

"I never watch TV during the week."

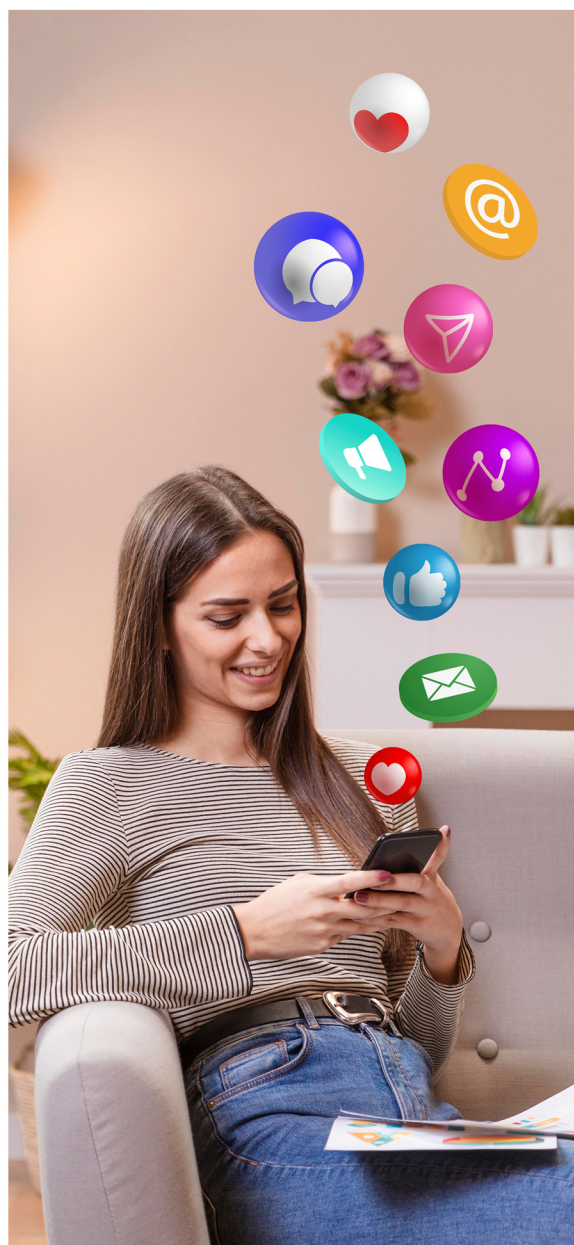
